ANNEX A

Official Controls Regulation (OCR) Tertiary Legislation

Most food law operating in the UK is derived from EU law. Following the end of the Implementation Period, these EU Food regulations have been retained as part of our domestic food law and have effect in domestic law immediately before exit day. Therefore from 1 January 2021 any references to EU Regulations should be read as referring to retained EU law which is published on legislation.gov.uk.

<u>Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/1873</u> on the procedures at border control posts for a coordinated performance by competent authorities of intensified official controls on products of animal origin, germinal products, animal by-products and composite products;

<u>Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2019/2007</u> laying down rules for the application of Regulation (EU) 2017/625 as regards the lists of animals, products of animal origin, germinal products, animal by- products and derived products and hay and straw subject to official controls at border control posts and amending Decision 2007/275/EC;

<u>Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/2074</u> supplementing Regulation (EU) 2017/625 as regards rules on specific official controls on consignments of certain animals and goods originating from, and returning to the Union following a refusal of entry by a third country;

Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/2090 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2017/625 regarding cases of suspected or established non-compliance with Union rules applicable to the use or residues of pharmacologically active substances authorised in veterinary medicinal products or as feed additives or with Union rules applicable to the use or residues of prohibited or unauthorised pharmacologically active substances.
