Local Authority Enforcement Monitoring System (LAEMS) Request for 2014/15 Returns

I would be grateful if your 2014/15 monitoring returns could be **uploaded** to LAEMS. However, we are aware of a problem with the LAEMS database at the business rules validation stage and we are working with our IT supplier to urgently try to rectify this. We will let you know once this is resolved so that the returns can then be validated, checked and signed off by the Head of Service.

The objective is to have the deadline for sign off as **Friday 29 May 2015**. This should enable us to collate the data and provide information back to local authorities following similar timescales as last year.

I would ask you to please contact me as soon as possible if you envisage any difficulties in meeting this deadline.

Annex - Important information for submitting 2014/15 LAEMS returns

Creating new users/resetting passwords

If you need to create new users or re-set passwords, your local authority LAEMS IT User has the facility to do this – see the guidance for more information.

If your IT user is not available you can still email us and we will do this for you, but please provide your user name and local authority (LA) code.

Sampling/enforcement data

LAs that have used UKFSS to record their samples for the whole of the 2014/15 reporting year have the option to use UKFSS data as the sample part of their relevant LAEMS return (food hygiene, food standards and imported food).

The FSA will download reports from UKFSS once we are assured that all relevant sample results have been uploaded by the laboratories. These reports will be sent to LAs to confirm whether they wish to use LAEMS or UKFSS data for their sample returns.

Could LAs/PHAs inputting food hygiene and food standards returns on LAEMS please remember to also complete their imported food return on LAEMS. LAs/PHAs (both those with points of entry and inland) are reminded to enter enforcement action data relating to imported foods onto the imported food section of LAEMS as these data are not on UKFSS.

Please note that if no imported food control data are submitted via LAEMS or UKFSS, the FSA will assume a nil return.
