Key findings from Wave 3



Some handwashing behaviours have decreased

- Always washing hands after handling rubbish has decreased to 64% in January (from 72% in October)
- Always washing hands after blowing nose, sneezing or coughing has fallen to 34%, from 41% in October



Soap and warm water still being used less frequently

 Always using soap and warm water to wash hands at home fell to 21% in January (18% in October), from a high in July of 27%



Decrease in activities outside the home • As expected, fewer people than in October report taking part in activities outside the home 'at the moment' overall.

Methodology


The Food Standards Agency (FSS) commissioned Ipsos MORI to track handwashing behaviour and attitudes during the COVID-19 pandemic and afterwards

This is the third of a quarterly tracker which will run for two years from July 2020 to April 2022.

During this wave, Ipsos MORI interviewed a representative sample of **511 adults, aged 16-75 living in Scotland.** Interviews were conducted online via i:Omnibus from: **15-18 January 2021.** The subgroups included highlight differences across some of the questions and are therefore useful comparators. Where subgroups are reported on, the base size is provided in the footnote.

The data is weighted to best reflect the demographic profile of the adult population sampled.


Where results do not sum to 100, this may be due to computer rounding. Where appropriate the 'not applicable' and 'don't know' responses are not shown.








Thinking about when you are at home at the moment, how often do you wash your hands in each of the following ways?



Time spent handwashing over time


Thinking about when you are at home at the moment. How many seconds do you spend washing your hands each time?










Prevalence of sore hands as a result of handwashing



What impact, if any, does getting sore hands have on the frequency with which you wash your hands?




















Frequency of handwashing facilities being unavailable


How often, if at all, do you find handwashing facilities are not available or not usable in the following places at the moment?


