- Any information relating to the food be modified, destroyed or disposed of;
- That any food which is fit for consumption can be returned to the person in charge of it or distributed to some other person.

In the event that the sheriff refuses to condemn the food as above, the food authority may be required to compensate the owner of the food for any depreciation in its value.
