NOTES

1. Having ascertained the status of the food with respect to Article 6(2) of Regulation (EU) 2015/2283, the Authorised Officer is now satisfied that the food specified in the Novel Food Notice need no longer be detained.
2. The relevant notice is now withdrawn.
3. If a notice served under subsection (2)(a) is withdrawn, or the sheriff by whom any food falls to be dealt with under section 9 of the Food Safety Act 1990 (as applied by regulation 5 (2) of the Novel Foods (Scotland) Regulations 2017) refuses to condemn it, the food authority may be required to compensate the owner of the food for any depreciation in its value resulting from the action taken by the Authorised Officer.
