Hi there. Just to make you aware that we have been advised of a fish farm barge sunken at mooring by Portree. The information provided thus far suggests that the vessel is intact and there is no fuel or chemical spillage, but that there will be some plastic detritus from the vessel in the water. I've checked with our shellfish team and there is a Cockle bed 2.3km away (Loch Portree Cockles) from the sunken vessel.

Just something to be aware of, Marine Scotland are monitoring the situation and will advise if the situation deteriorates.
