Hi 38(1)b,

Thank you for checking that and passing on the information about the cockle bed. I will let the MCA know as they are in direct contact with the operator.

I have attached the latest email update, received today. It looks like they are hoping to pump the fuel from the main fuel tank today and, over the next few days, ensure that all remaining fuel has been removed. Next week, they are then planning to seal the silo's containing the fish feed which will then be left in situ until the barge is lifted. This is likely to be March 2022 when the site is next fallow.

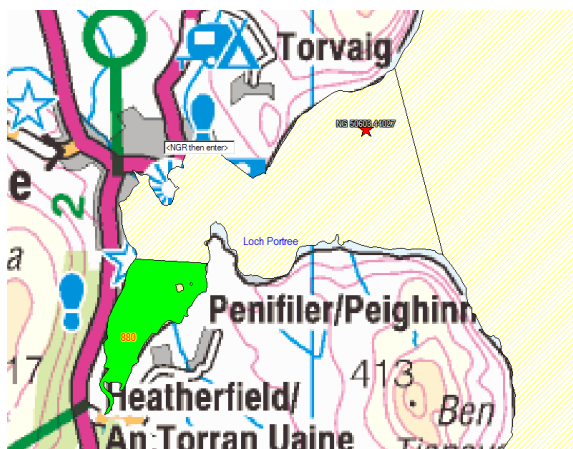
I will let you know if there are any further significant developments. Otherwise, just let me know if you have any further concerns from today's update.
