We're here to support food businesses, giving them the advice and help they need to comply with food and feed law and make sure food is safe.

The Scottish Food Crime and Incidents Unit (SFCIU) includes the investigations and intelligence gathering arms FSS. They focus on tackling food crime and maintaining consumer protection in relation to the Scottish food and drink industry.

FSS is reminding businesses and consumers of the dangers of counterfeit alcohol. This is illegally produced alcohol that is often packaged to look like legitimate, well-known brands but frequently contains toxic chemicals that pose severe health risks if consumed.

Food businesses and consumers can report any concerns 100% anonymously to the Scottish Food Crime Hotline, run in partnership by FSS with Crimestoppers.


